**Subject: Complaint Against Manish Grover, Ex. MLA, Rohtak to use abusing Language to SP, Rohtak.**

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to bring to your immediate attention a serious matter concerning the recent actions of Mr. Manish Grover, former MLA from Rohtak, which have resulted in significant disruption and concern within our community.

On [25.08.2024, Approx 8:30 PM], Mr. Manish Grover, along with a large group of his supporters, staged an illegal protest outside the office of the Superintendent of Police in Rohtak. During this illegal protest, they blocked the entire Main road, causing severe inconvenience to the residents of the city. The situation escalated to the point where the residents were not only inconvenienced but felt under duress due to the aggressive nature of the illegal protest without permission. While Model Code of Conduct schedule issued on 16/8/2024, by Election Commission of India. This illegal protest is used only for disturbing the resident of the city.

Moreover, it has been reported that supporters of Mr. Grover attacked the police, further escalating tensions and disturbing the peace and order of the city. This incident has left the city in a state of unrest, causing significant distress among its residents.

What is particularly disturbing is that Mr. Grover made public allegations against the Superintendent of Police, accusing him and others of misconduct. These actions are not only a violation of the Model Code of Conduct but also constitute an open threat to the administration. Mr.

Grover's statements and actions are an attempt to coerce the administration into registering a criminal case under duress, which is a clear abuse of power and an affront to the rule of law.

I urge the Election Commission to take immediate cognizance of these facts and issue necessary directions to ensure that law and order are maintained in Rohtak. It is imperative that such actions are not allowed to go unchecked, as they set a dangerous precedent and threaten the integrity of the electoral process.

I request that the Election Commission investigate this matter thoroughly and take appropriate action against Mr. Manish Grover and his supporters to prevent further disruption and maintain the sanctity of the law.
